

Black Creek District Campership Request Form

Black Creek District is committed to the premise that every Scout deserves the chance to attend an extended camp and that no Scout should miss camp because of a lack of funds. To fulfill this commitment, Black Creek District maintains a Campership Program to help deserving Scouts who could not otherwise afford camp attendance fees. This program is not intended to cover all of the camp cost. Paying a Scout's way is a joint effort of the Scout Unit, the Scout, his family and the Campership Program.

OMMISSION OF SIGNATURES AND OTHER REQUESTED INFORMATION WILL RESULT IN THE DELAY AND/OR REJECTION OF THE APPLICATION.

- Applications need to be completed and answers need to be thorough. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The application needs to be signed by the Unit Leader. By applying for a campership, the Unit Leader is affirming there is a financial need. Unit Leader(s) please ensure SECTION A and SECTION B are completed prior to submitting.
- Funds are available for the following:
 - Boy Scouts can attend an approved BSA Nationally Accredited long-term overnight resident camp (four or more consecutive nights) or attend an approved troop organized non-accredited BSA overnight summer camp program (application must be accompanied by an itinerary of the camp activities and a tour plan).
 - Cub Scouts can attend an approved BSA Nationally Accredited Day or Twilight Camp (four or more consecutive days) OR attend an approved BSA Nationally Accredited Webelos Residents Camp (three or more consecutive nights).
- Because there are limited funds to be awarded; the applications will be prioritized in the following order:
 - First time campership applicants with NO previous extended camp experience.
 - First time campership applicants with previous extended camp experience.
 - All other campership request.
- A scout may receive up to 75% of the equivalent North Florida Council (NFC) base camp fee as funds allow. (No late fees and/or additional activity fees will be included and/or considered.) Depending on the availability of funds & the number of applicant's percentage of moneys awarded may be reduced. Below are the committee's guidelines.
 - First time application for camp, up to 75% of NFC equivalent camp base fee.
 - Second time application for camp, up to 50% of NFC equivalent camp base fee.
 - Third time application for camp, up to 25% of NFC equivalent camp base fee.
- All applications are due by **March 10** (summer) & **October 10** (winter) to the Campership Committee. Late applications are subject to the availability of funds. **DO NOT** submit your application via NFC; as to avoid any issues and/or delays.
- If a Scout applies for and receives other financial assistance to cover camping expenses, the Scout must notify the Black Creek Campership Committee. Funds issued by the campership fund cannot in combination with other financial rewards exceed 100% of camp cost. It is the responsibility of the Scout, the Unit Leader, and the Parent/Guardian to report all other scholarships received as soon as possible and/or return any overage of funds received; so that other scout needs can be met.
- Funds cannot be retroactive; i.e. A Scout and/or Unit cannot pay for camp up front and then request to be reimbursed.
