Come join us at Camp Shands for the Inaugural Webelos Resident Camp. You will learn the skills to be a boy scout.

Session A: 2pm June 29th to 11am July 2nd

Session B: 2pm July 2nd to 11am July 5th

Cost \$100 per Scout if paid in full by May 2
\$115 per Scout if paid in full May 3 – May 30
\$130 per Scout if paid in full June 1 – June 29
Registration begins February 19
First 25 paid Webelos will stay in our Treehouses!
Fees include meals, program items, patch, and more
Pay by mail or in person at the North Florida Council
Limited to first 400 paid youth and adults per session



Adults Two adults required for each pack (except for Packs with only one Scout and one parent)
One adult free for every four paid Webelos
Two adults free for every eight paid Webelos and so on
Additional Adults - \$50

Who May Attend – Webelos Scouts that will be in the 4th and 5th Grade in the Fall of 2008 along with leaders and parents.



On arrival Webelos and Adults will be assigned by pack to their camp site. Check in time is from 1 to 2pm.

Meals Balanced meals served in our air conditioned dining hall

Coffee hot and fresh for adults every morning

Meals begin with lunch 1st day and end with breakfast last day

Activities – Swimming, canoeing, crafts, archery, BB guns, games, fun, water carnival, watermelon fest, special 4th of July celebration, campfires, nature and MORE

Accommodations – Scouts will be in campsites with their pack

Large wall tents with two cots and wooden pallet floors. Bring a sleeping bag pillows

Flushing toilets in each campsite

Electricity in each site

Private showers available

Medical Arrangements – A certified medical officer is on camp at all times

All medications must be distributed through the medical officer

A class 1 and 2 medical form is required for all youth and adult participants, adults over 40 a

Class 3 medical form is required for 40 years old and older.

What to Bring – Sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight, insect repellent, sunscreen, uniform, changes of clothes, swimsuit, towels, toiletries, medications, Webelos book,

What not to Bring – Fireworks, Game systems and electronic devices, sheath knives, alcohol, and bad attitudes

Directions From Jacksonville – Take Florida State Road 21 (Blanding Blvd) south from Jacksonville.

Travel SR 21 through Keystone Heights and Melrose. Approximately 3 miles past Melrose turn east (left) onto Baden Powell Road. The entrance to Camp Shands is located 2.8 miles on the right marked by large stone pillars.

Directions From Gainesville – From I 75 take the University Blvd exit and travel east on University Blvd

(SR 26). Cross US 301 and continue to SR 21 in Melrose. Turn right on SR 21. After this turn travel approximately 3 miles and turn east (left) onto Baden Powell Road. The entrance to Camp Shands is located 2.8 miles on the right marked by large stone pillars
