



Welcome to Black Creek's Twilight Camp 2010!

This is your guide to great fun and
adventure!

Who: All Cub Scouts from Tigers(with adult partner) to Webelos and Tag-a-longs (as long as your mom or dad is working at camp)

What: Cub-A-Saurs Twilight Camp 2010

When: July 19-23 from 6:00PM to 9:30PM. You may drop your scout off **no earlier than 5:45PM**. Opening Ceremony starts promptly at 6:00PM. Scout pick up starts at 9:30PM. Please look for signs at camp for directions to pickup/drop off. Both will be near Ashley Lodge.

Where: Camp Echockotee, Doctor's Lake Dr., Orange Park

Things to know before first day of camp:

-Forms-Please have all the necessary forms completed and ready to turn in to staff. This includes the health form (on back of the registration form) and all the applicable forms attached to this guide.

-Pre-camp orientation/check-in and Swim Test- Sunday, July 18 from 1PM-3PM will be the pre-camp check-in and orientation. You will learn your scout's den information and preview the week's schedule. This will save you lots of time opening day of camp! You will drop your scout off with his den leader instead of standing in line at the check-in table! Swim level testing will also be available during this time, as well.

-Dismissal- Campers will **ONLY** be released to their parent/guardian. If your camper will need to ride home with someone else, you **MUST** complete the attached carpool or pick up authorization form. Please place a large legible sign on the right side of your dashboard that has your camper's name and den number on it. If you have permission to carpool other campers, please have their names and den numbers, as well. This will speed up the pick up process. Your patience during dismissal is greatly appreciated.

Supplies your camper will need each day:** Please Note: LABEL EVERYTHING**

- Back pack for belongings
- Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. No sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or Aqua socks.
- Bathing suit and towel - campers will swim every day weather permitting. (They can wear their suit and change into dry clothes or not. There is limited time so wearing the suit is easier.)
- Bug spray(lotion or wipe style only)
- Place **snack** in a ziploc plastic bag with child's name and den number on the bag. No paper bags (snacks are kept in ice chest if need to be chilled). Please no Lunchables as there is limited disposal of trash at den areas. Den leaders **do not** provide snacks.
- Water or sports drink is the best for rehydrating your camper. Mugs will be provided the first day and each activity area will have water coolers available.
- Camp T-shirt must be worn every day for security purposes. This will be provided first day of camp.
- Medicines to be taken at camp must be turned in to the Camp Nurse in Ashley Lodge.
- No personal electronic devices of any kind are allowed.

Please review these rules with your camper before camp:

1. Have respect for Den leader(s), Den chief, Den aide, and Instructors.
2. Have respect for Den mates. No name calling or fighting is allowed.
3. Keep your hands to yourself. No Hitting. **Ask** before you bother anyone else's belongings.
4. **Do Not** throw rocks, sticks, or other items.
5. **No Tree Climbing.**
6. No cutting or collecting bamboo or any vegetation.
7. Water front area, creeks, lagoon area, Swimming Hole (Adjacent to WW Gay Shelter) and Amphitheater are off limits, unless supervised by a leader.
8. Nothing is to be put in the toilets, except what your body puts there. Use only provided toilets.
9. Closed toe shoes and socks must be worn outside of pool area at all times (No sandals, flip flops, Crocs, or aqua socks).
10. Each boy is responsible for his own belongings.
11. Littering will not be tolerated.
12. Always use the buddy system, and tell your leader before going away from den or den area.

The Camp Director has the right to dismiss any boy from camp for misconduct. It is also at the discretion of the Camp Director to refuse re-admission to camp. Refunds will not be offered.

Camp Security

- Camp T-shirts must be worn every day by everyone.
- Identification of Staff Member - Gray T-Shirts
- Identification of Boys – Yellow T-Shirts
- All camp visitors and volunteers/parents not wearing a Staff T-Shirt must sign in at Camp Check In/Ashley Lodge to receive a visitor name tag. A valid ID is needed to enter camp.
- All camp visitors without Staff T-shirt or visitor badge **should** be challenged and escorted to Camp Check In/Ashley Lodge. Camp Directors should be notified.
- Late Check-in- Sign your camper in at the Ashley Lodge with the Camp Nurse first. **DO NOT** report straight to the camper's den leader.
- Early Check-out – Report to the Ashley Lodge and check out your camper with the Camp Nurse. Your camper will be brought to you. **DO NOT** report straight to the camper's den leader. Only authorized persons may pick up a boy from camp. Written permission slip from parent is required. If your scout is carpooling with another scout's parent, please turn in a signed permission slip on or before the first day of camp with the name and contact information of the parent that will be picking up the scouts (see attached car pool form). Scouts **will not** be released to anyone else.
- BSA Guidelines will be enforced at all times.
